

Professor Santiago González y Fernández-Corugedo obtained a Master of Arts degree in English Linguistics (Oviedo, 1981) and a doctorate in Comparative Linguistics (Oviedo, 1987). Since 1996 he holds the chair of English Philology at the University of Oviedo. He was previously appointed chair of English Language & Linguistics at the University of Corunna (1994-1996) where he also served as Dean of its Facultade de Filoloxía (Arts Faculty). He has also served as consul of education of Spain in Miami (FL) (2004 & 2005), with jurisdiction over the US Southeast.

He was postdoctoral research fellow at the University of Oxford (Duke Humphrey's in the Bodleian Library: 1990, 1991, 1992), where he also held a visiting fellowship from the Oxford University Humanities Computing Services in 1998. He was visiting fellow at the University of Toronto Centre for Medieval Studies (2000), and Visiting Professor at Whitman College, Washington (2002).

Professor Fernández-Corugedo has been the editor of the academic journals *Atlantis* (1997 & 1998); *Sederi* (1996-2000); and coeditor of *Selim* (1991-2000, 2004-...). He chaired the Spanish Society for Medieval English Language and Literature from 1999 to 2004. He is currently a member of different boards and committees of academic journals and learned societies.

Main fields of Publication: English Romantic Poets [4 books and 9 articles] on Blake, Wordsworth, Coleridge, Shelley; Edmund Spenser, John Donne and other Tudor writers [1 book, 8 articles]; Medieval Studies & History of English [3 books, 11 articles]; Electronic editions and ecdotics [3 hypertexts]. He has also translated a sundry number of various books into Spanish.

He usually teaches undergraduate courses in English Historical Linguistics, Medieval Studies and English Language, and has taught PhD and postgraduate courses at 14 different Universities, including special programmes in Translation Studies, Textual and Cultural Studies in English, and English Language and Linguistics.
