- Spain:

- 17 autonomous communities and 2 "autonomous cities"
- Population: 47.3 million
- Area: 505,900 km²

- Castilla y León:

- 9 provinces (Ávila, Burgos, León, Palencia, Salamanca, Segovia, Soria, Valladolid y Zamora).
- Population: 2.4 million

Area: 94.226 km²









Basic Law on Education (2/2006, 3 May)

PURPOSE OF ADULT EDUCATION

To offer people over eighteen the possibility to acquire, update, complete or add to their knowledge and skills for professional and personal development.

Basic Law on Education (2/2006, 3 May)

RECIPIENTS

- People over the age of eighteen.
- Young people over the age of sixteen, may, as an exception, attend adult education,
 - if they have a employment contract which does not allow them to attend normal educational institutions
 - or if they are high performance sportsmen or sportswomen.



Framework for Lifelong Learning in Castilla y León

- Strategic objectives:
 - 1. To keep **illiteracy eradicated** and contribute to raising the level of **key skills** (**basic skills**) for lifelong learning in the adult population.
 - 2. To promote the **reintegration into the education system of people under 30** who left it early, as well as their training and qualification.
 - 3. To improve the employability of adults, particularly those socially disadvantaged groups, facilitating the development of professional skills.
- This framework was approved in 2017 by the Council of Adult Education of Castilla y León.





2. Structure: adult education teachings

The educational offer for adults is organised in 3 training areas of knowledge:

Education area concerned to access other levels of the educational system

Training area concerned to professional development

Training area concerned to personal and social development




