

eLearning in Business Education

Knowledge is a powerful business tool that ensures the sustainability and range of skills.

An efficacy and efficiency's key factor, as well as a fit qualification for the workers and their continuous knowledge renewal.

Emphasis on business qualification and not on the certification process.

It cannot be forgotten that this qualification form demands an investment return.



eLearning presents several benefits for the business context:

It allows the company/organization to renew and develop its work knowledge while, at the same time, enhancing its resources.



It helps the workers to achieve efficacy in their jobs.

It contributes to problem solving.

It allows a rapid learning that results in professional development.

Universidade Aberta, in partnership with a big national company, analyses the company's eLearning development to improve and enhance the work already been done by them.



Methodological and learning aspects found in most business-elearning courses

- Methodological strategies presented by a contextualised video.
- Teaching methodology centred on the instructors.
- Sometimes the course goals get confused with the instructors goals; resulting in unclear goals to be achieved by the students.
- Overall, the courses are sequential, with not much interaction or direct participation from the students. There is no room for queries, reflexions nor posts to interact directly with a tutor.
- Self-training methodology.
- Preset course conclusion time: the students are unable to control and manage their own studies' time-table.
