Public employment services

- In EU countries, public employment services (PES) are the authorities that connect jobseekers with employers.
- Although structured differently in each country, all PES help match supply and demand on the labour market through information, placement and active support services at local, national and European level.

Agenzia Nazionale per le Politiche Attive del Lavoro (ANPAL)

National Agency For Working Policies was established in 2015: its main objective is the coordination of labor policies in favor of jobseekers and the relocation of the unemployed and the creation of an electronic file for each worker. The information system and the worker's electronic dossier are aimed at better managing the labor market and monitoring the services provided. All information contained in the information system is made available to the Regions.

The Veneto Region has its own office, Veneto Lavoro, which plays a support role in the regional policies concerning work and monitoring in the actions of the Region concerning work. The CPIA collaborates with Veneto Lavoro, through the Regional Scholastic Office, especially in the management of funds coming from the European Union for teaching Italian to foreigners.



CPIA works in close contact with the Province of Padua, especially with the office called “Center for Employment” that deals with:

- people of working age who are looking for a first job
- unemployed looking for employment
- employers who are looking for staff
- people who want to change jobs or improve their job position



The Center for employment also collects students under the age of 18 who do not go to school, they are the so called Early School Leavers; these students are referred to the CPIA and the Vocational Training Centers in order to include them at school again or to provide them a work.
