


HIGH COMMISSION FOR MIGRATION (ACM, I.P.)

Public Institution having the mission of collaborating on determining, executing and assessing the public, transversal and sectorial policies concerning migrations that are relevant for the integration of migrants in the national, international and Portuguese-speaking contexts, for the integration of the immigrants and ethnic groups — in particular, the gypsy communities — and for managing and valuing of the diversity between cultures, ethnics and religions.

- Partnership between the High Commission for Migration (ACM, I.P.) and the Employment Institute (IEFP, I.P.);
- Involvement of 10 public and private non-profit entities, responsible to maintain these services especially oriented to migrants, working in close cooperation with the local Employment Centres.

Goals


- Support in job search and training;

EMPLOYMENT, HIGHER EDUCATION AND QUALIFICATION SUPPORT OFFICE

Aims to help reduce barriers and to facilitate equal access to job and qualification opportunities

Employability

- Curriculum vitae and other documents that may be requested in the job search process (such as a motivation letter);
- Referrals for appropriate job offers based on the professional skills and /or qualifications of each migrant;
- To schedule interviews with different companies and employers;
- Job search techniques.

Entrepreneurship

- Basic information about the key aspects to start a business;
- Direct articulation with GAEM Migrant Entrepreneurship Support Office that provides specialized assistance and training programs (amongst other initiatives).

Promotion of Immigrant Entrepreneurship Project (PEI)

Goal: Aims to support migrants in the development of a bussiness idea

Activities: training course (10 weeks) and technichal support

How: (a) active metodologies; (b) trainer support; (c) involvement of other organizations

Where: National Support Centre for Migrants (Lisbon and Porto); Municipalities; NGO




