









- Italian Language A2 (CEFR) in 2 years
- Participate to a CIVIC EDUCATION SESSION within 90 days (KOS=Test of knowledge of Society)

2. The Civic Education Session (CES)



What is the Civic Education Session

- It is a mandatory training course of civil life in Italy
- Materials: 5 hours of multilingual videos from the Ministry of Education
- □ 10 hours of lessons
- Mandatory by 90 days
- □ Non participation = -15 credits
- They are held in the CPIA (Provincial Center for Adult Education)





Session topics

1. Constitution and public institutions (entry into Italy, the house)

2. Civil life in Italy (school, health, work, social services, tax obligations)

3. Rights and duties of foreigners in Ita

4. Health and safety at work





The Guidelines suggest that CES should be designed by the teachers involved in adult education centres









The materials consists of 5 video of 1 hour each available in 17 languages





Example of contents

Firstly it must be said the under the Constitution Work is first and foremost a right, because only by working can you live freely and with dignity. Critical issues

- Videos are long and uninteresting
- Language is too bureaucratic and difficult
- Difficulty of inviting a linguistic mediator
- No interaction
- Multilingual groups




RESIDENCE PERMIT

ENTRY VISA

Issued in the country of origin. It is necessary to enter Italy.



OFFICE FOR IMMIGRATION

It is in the QUESTURA and it deals with passports and residence



ONE-STOP-SHOP FOR IMMIGRATION

It is an office of the Prefecture and it helps you to gather all documents for a residence permit and for family



CAF (CENTRE FOR FISCAL ASSISTANCE)

it helps you preparing all documents to pay taxes.



DRIVING LICENCE

Document that is required to drive motorcycles, cars and trucks. It must always be shown to any cop, local police and carabiniere that asks for it.



QUESTURA

Police Headquarters.



PREFECTURE

It is responsible for coordinating public safety and the police.

Materials: folders

- Printed material that accompanies the video.
- Website from which to download the folders

CPIA Verona Research

- Students are generally very attentive, and participate when it comes to health and school
- Less interest in attention when the issues of Constitution and public institutions are dealt with

Consider the civic training session as a useful training opportunity



Many do not know they have signed the integration agreement and have made commitments with the Italian State





4. Conclusions

Conclusions:

- CES as opportunity both for CPIA and the migrants
- The need for a dialogue between the experiences of different CPIAs, the institutions and the Universities
- Make the Agreement more readable and understandable
- Translate and produce better explanatory materials

- Civic training should take place within a literacy course in Italian
- The establishment a periodic investigation of the effectiveness of both the agreement and the civic training session
- Yet No-consequences for "family" immigrants, and asylum immigrants, so it has a limited impact
