














#### **CPIA**














### From 1997 to 2015 ...

... since 2015 ...

- 128 CPIA based in all the Italian provinces
- 1.800 supply points during the school year2016 2017
- 230.000 educational agreements signed by adults who come back to school to get a qualification (migrants, unemployed people without a qualification, adolescents who abandoned school)
















#### CPIA in Veneto Region

- Italian language knowledge test according to D.M.
   4/6/2010 for immigrants who need the long term
   Resident Permit.
- **Civic Education** sessions according to D.P.R. n. 179 14/9/2011.
- Integration Agreement exam sessions.
















#### Padua CPIA activities

- institutional courses
  - education and literacy Italian L2 courses
    - compulsory school
  - Italian courses in jails
- institutional agreements
  - with regular compulsory school to help 15-year-old students with Italian language weaknesses
  - with high schools to allow students going to school in the morning and attending CPIA courses in the afternoon to get a sixth grade diploma














#### Padua CPIA activities














### CIVIS V project

Migrant Citizenship and Integration in Veneto region

"Cittadinanza e Integrazione in Veneto degli Immigrati Stranieri" The project establishes that CPIA in Veneto Region has to run Italian courses and civic program courses for people coming from countries out of the **European Union**.

Its aim is to allow them to get the A2 level of Italian language knowledge and also a proper knowledge of civic Italian culture and social Italian life to meet the standards required to obtain the long term residency permit.














### CIVIS V project

- This project is supported by EU funds and its main partners are: Italian Ministry of the Interior, Italian Ministry of Education and Veneto Region.
- It is the first and only experience in Italy which is coordinated at regional level: it involves all the seven
   CPIA schools in Veneto.
- The main goal is literacy education and Italian learning education for illiterate or without schooling skill migrants and people who are especially exposed to social exclusion.















### CIVIS V project

funds distribution (total amount: € 24.000.000,00)


















### CIVIS V project

The **beneficiaries** (it's totally free) of educational actions are people living in Veneto:

- not European citizens with residency permit;
- international shelters as refugees, or subsidiary protection status owners;
- helpless people as women, pregnant women, children at risk of social exclusion, unaccompanied minors, illiterates, physically disabled people, people having cognitive difficulties and victims of trafficking.














### CIVIS V project

- The Project started in November 2016 and ended in March 2018.
- The team of teachers who works in Padua CPIA is involved in teaching literacy and Italian language.
- All of them are committed in providing Italian language courses from pre-A1 to B1 levels, according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages - CEFR.








Veneto data: 3044 students














# Employment at the beginning of the courses
















## attending (F) and and retiring (R) students




















Attending school in the past ... (years)
